



NESTON TOWN COUNCIL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL ALLOTMENT HOLDERS

- Where it is a lockable site the allotment holders should be responsible for ensuring the gate is locked at all times, to prevent unauthorised persons gaining access to the site.
- The allotment holder must accompany all visitors and children on site and be responsible for them at all times.
- Dogs brought onto the allotment must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Allotments holders must not deposit any rubbish/materials on any vacant plots or other allotment holders plots.
- Allotment holders must not remove any materials from any vacant plots.
- Allotment holders must not remove any crops from another tenants plot without their permission.
- Where there is a car park - cars must be parked on the car park only and not on the access footpaths. The only exception being for loading or unloading and then cars must be removed immediately afterwards.
- Allotment holders who light fires must ensure the fire is supervised at all times. In the interests of safety any fire must be fully extinguished before the allotment holder leaves the site.
- Allotment holders and authorised visitors must respect other allotment holder's privacy and their right to peace and quiet whilst on their plot.
- Allotment holders who have a grievance or wish to report any other allotment holder , who is in violation of their allotment tenancy, can contact their spokesperson or Council officer.
- N.B. Remember that each allotment site is a community and all tenants should help and support others where possible to maximise the enjoyment of allotment gardening.
- 'Trailers and vehicles may be used when loading and unloading, but are prohibited from being stored overnight. They must not block the footpath or access to any other allotment plot holders plot for any prolonged period of time.'
